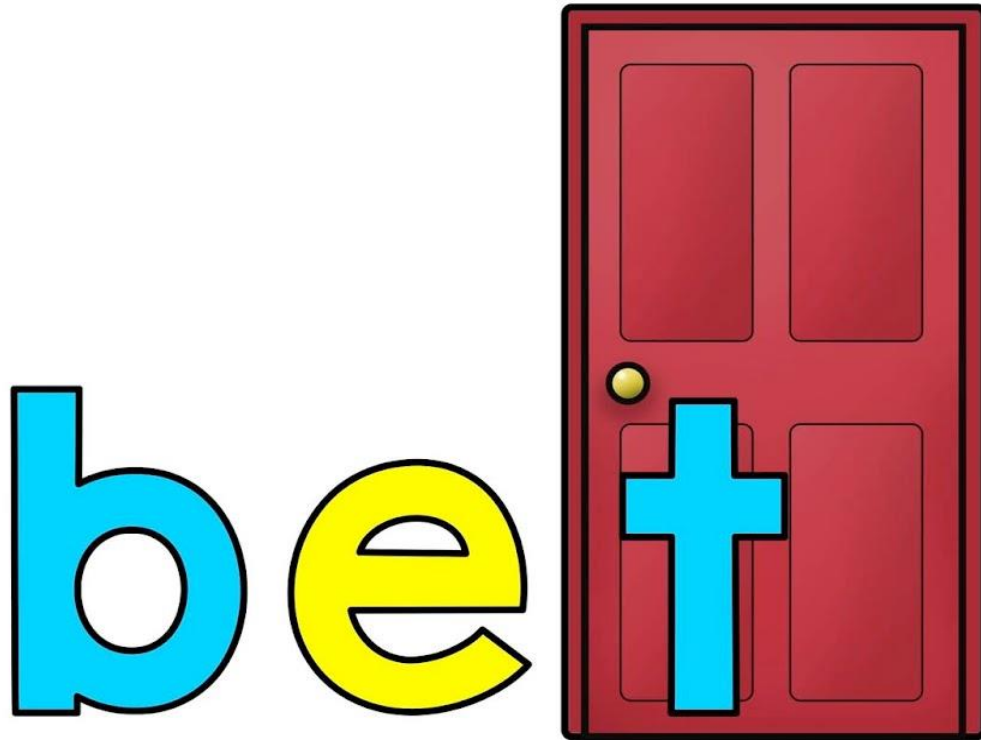


Closed Syllables

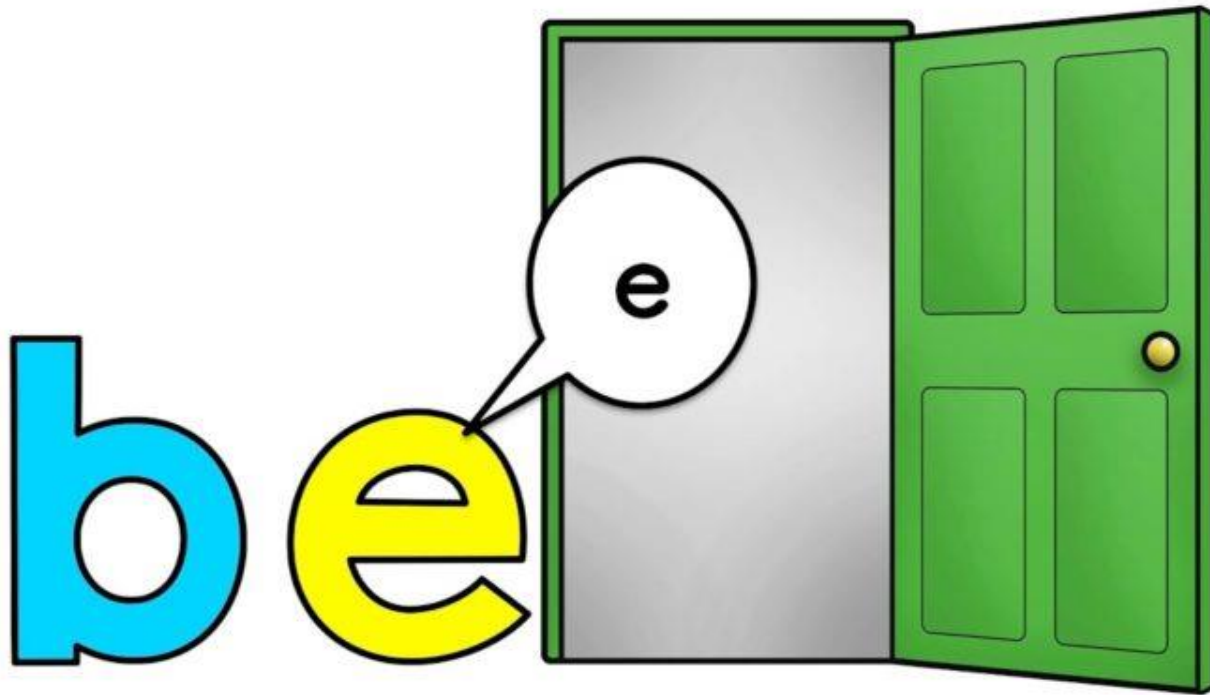
Consonants close the door so the vowel can NOT say its name. Use the short vowel sound.



When a syllable has one **vowel** followed by one or more **consonants**, that vowel will make its short sound.

Open Syllables

There is no consonant closing this vowel in. Use the long vowel sound.



When a syllable ends with a **vowel**, that syllable is OPEN, so the vowel can **say its name**.
